## The Susan Laughter Meyers Summer Scholarship Contest Guidelines

The Scholarship, honoring the late Susan Laughter Meyers, covers full tuition for a poet to the 2019 Hub City's Writing in Place Conference, lodging in a college dormitory, conference-provided meals, and a manuscript conference with faculty. The annual conference, held in July at Wofford College in Spartanburg, SC, gives writers an opportunity to study poetry in a workshop setting, generate new work, and attend faculty readings.

Application is open to any current adult member of The Poetry Society of South Carolina, except previous winners; online submissions only.

The application manuscript should consist of five poems (no more than 10 pages total), with only one poem per page. The poems must be typed, single-spaced standard typeface (e.g., Times Roman, Garamond), 12 pt. The manuscript must be submitted blind – without the author's name appearing anywhere in it. All 5 poems should be in one file. The file should be named with the title of the first poem in the manuscript. No reading fee is required.
